There will be catering on the showground on the day

#### RULES - Please take the time to read these rules

- 1. No substitution/nomination entries permitted. All incorrect entries will be returned.
- 2. Spurs/dress spurs must not be worn in ANY Mountain and Moorland Ridden classes.
- 3. Hard hats to the current BSH standard must be worn at all times when mounted
- 4. Foals must be at least 4 weeks old.
- 5. All stallions 4 years old and over must hold a current licence

6. Stallions/Colts may not be led by juniors who have not attained their 14th birthday before 1 Jan in the current year.

7. Any pony stallion n/e 138cms or small breed M&M may NOT be ridden by juniors under 12 years of age on 1st Jan in the current year. Stallions exc. 138cms and large breed M&M stallions may not be ridden by juniors under 14 years of age on 1st Jan in the current year.

8. Novice ponies are not to have won £10 or more before the 1st January in the current year.

9. Exhibitors must not enter an animal bred by the judge or the judge has a financial involvement with.

10. It is the competitors' responsibility to ensure they are in the ring in their correct class. No refund of entry fee shall be made if a competitor misses their class.

11. It is the exhibitor/owner's responsibility to ensure that the animal to be shown is entered in the correct class. Once the catalogue is printed and forwarded to the WPCS the animal cannot be transferred into another class and the entry fee is forfeited.

12. The Judge's decision is final. If there is only 1 entry forward the judge may award whichever prize warranted by that entry.

13. Objections must be lodged with the Secretary within 10 minutes of the class finishing with a deposit of £30 which will be refunded if the objection is sustained. Certain complaints cannot be dealt with immediately and will be addressed at the next planned committee meeting. You will be notified accordingly. Any verbal abuse or aggression towards committee/show organisers will not be tolerated under any circumstances and you will be expelled from the showground.

- 14. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday
- 15. Ponies are to be entered in the name of the Legal owner and with their correct registered name and number.
- 16. Medals are offered to Champions or Reserves in accordance with WPCS regulations
- 17. All exhibits in Welsh classes must be registered in the Welsh Stud Book with the exclusion of foals.
- 18. The EMWPCA accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury however caused.
- 19. Entrants are strongly advised to provide their own 3rd party insurance cover.
- 20. The Show is run under EMWPCA, WP&C Society rules.

21. EMWPCA reserve the right to alter classes or judges without notice. It is the Judge/committees discretion as to whether a class is held up for an exhibitor in another ring.

- 22. No mucking out of boxes on the ground and no litter please.
- 23. No Motorcycles, bicycles or Quad bikes on the showground or in the horsebox park.
- 24. In the event of the show being cancelled due to circumstances beyond our control no refunds will be given.

- 2. b) Where classes are amalgamated at, the highest placed of each breed may go forward to the Championship at that Show.
- 3. c) Handler any age, except stallions (see rules in section A 3.2).
- 4. d) The owner does not have to be an NPS member for the pony to enter the championship but only ponies owned by NPS Qualifying or Life members can receive the Silver Medal Rosette and qualify for the final at which a Gold Medal is presented. (see section A 1.3 a)
- 5. e) The Silver Medal Rosette goes to the Champion, if owned by an NPS member. If the Champion is not owned by an NPS member the Silver Medal Rosette goes to the Reserve if it is owned by an NPS member. Silver Medal Rosette to go no lower than first Reserve (third) provided it is owned by an NPS Member.

The qualification and the Sponsor's Rosette go to the Champion, if owned by an NPS member and not already qualified for the M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship final. If the Champion is not owned by an NPS Members or has already qualified then the qualification and the Sponsor's Rosette go to the Reserve Champion, if owned by an NPS member, unless he has already qualified. Qualification and Sponsor's Rosette to go no lower than first Reserve (third) provided it is owned by an NPS Member. At Breed Shows owners do not have to be NPS members to receive the Silver Medal or qualify for the final.

Ponies qualifying in Scotland can go forward to **either** the Scotland M&M In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship final at Blair or the Silver Medal Rosette Championship final at the NPS Summer Championship show at Malvern. The first qualification awarded will take precedence irrespective of the country where the qualification was won. A pony may only qualify for the Silver Medal Final once in a season.

Ponies qualifying outside Scotland go forward to the Silver Medal Rosette Championship final at the NPS Summer Championship show.

Class 32 Mountain and Moorland Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, registered in the Pure Bred Section of the Breed Societies Stud Books of the New Forest and Connemara.

Class 33 Mountain and Moorland Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 years old and over, registered in the Pure Bred Section of the Breed Societies Stud Books of the Dales, Fell, Highlands.

Class 34 Mountain and Moorland Stallion, Mare or Gelding, 4 registered in the Pure Bred Section of the Breed Societies Stud Books of the Welsh C and Welsh D.

#### Class 36 THE NPS/BRYNDEFAID MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND NOVICE FIRST RIDDEN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Ponies never to have won a first prize of  $\pm 10$  or more in any First Ridden M&M classes or qualified for the NPS/Showing Classics M&M First Ridden final before  $1^{st}$  January in current year.
